Integrating Isabel elinvoice with your applications

Isabel elinvoice uses the BMF standard for integration with invoicing & accounting applications. Integration allows automatization of the complete invoice exchange cycle. Automatization generates important benefits like faster invoicing handling, reduction of costs and fewer errors. The BMF format is already supported by major software houses including Popsy, Solid Data, SAP, AXI, Icore and Organi. The BMF specifications are available at www.elinvoice.be.

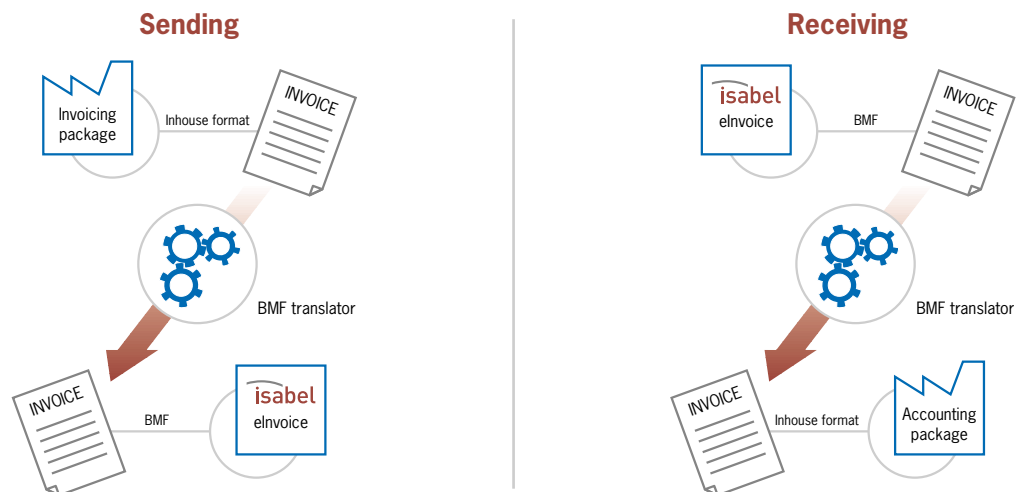
What if your applications do not support BMF yet?

Your current invoicing and accounting solutions might not support BMF yet. However, most packages do support import and export of at least one in-house format like XML or TXT-files (ASCII or CSV). Adding a translator will allow you to integrate Isabel elinvoice with virtually all your applications. You want to use another format with Isabel elinvoice? Just install the correct translator and there you go.

The dedicated translator "TIE BMF Module" converts XML or TXT from your applications to a valid BMF invoice you can send with Isabel. This translator is easy to interface with your solutions so you can make this totally transparent for the users.
